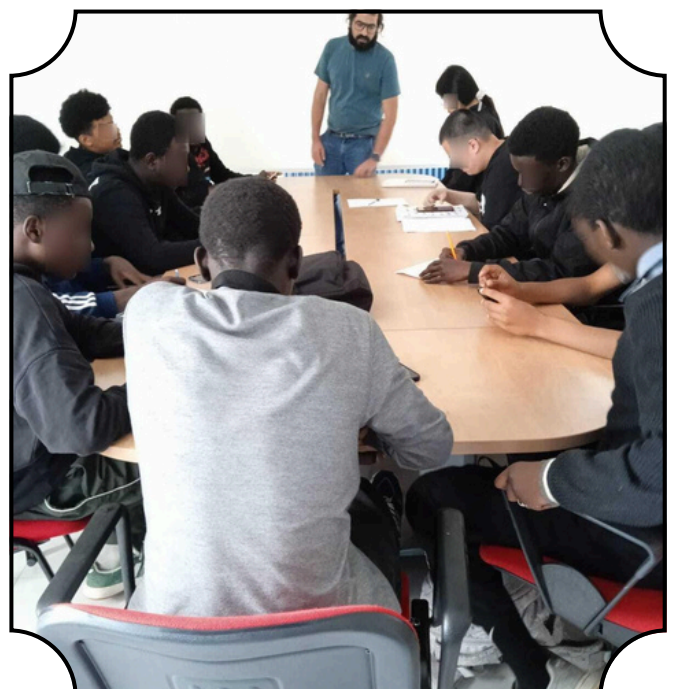
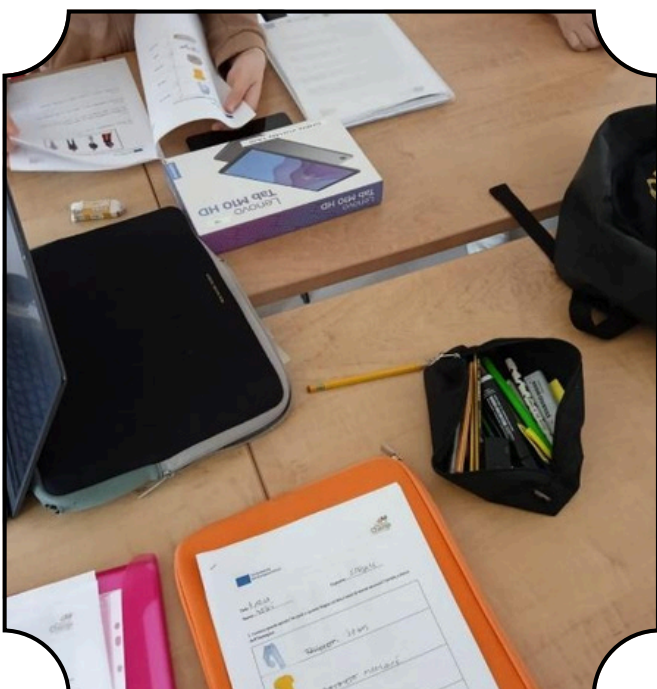
We're excited to share the latest steps forward in our mission to support migrant children through education and social inclusion.

WP4 Debate Labs Continue - Language, Confidence and Participation

This month, the project activities continued with new workshops involving children and young people from migrant backgrounds. Through language support activities, participants had the opportunity to strengthen their communication skills while improving confidence in everyday interactions and group discussions.

Alongside the linguistic support, the workshops introduced the basics of debate: how to express ideas, listen to others, build arguments, and participate respectfully in a shared discussion.

Using interactive games, collaborative exercises, and guided conversations, the activities created an engaging environment where learning became both practical and inclusive.



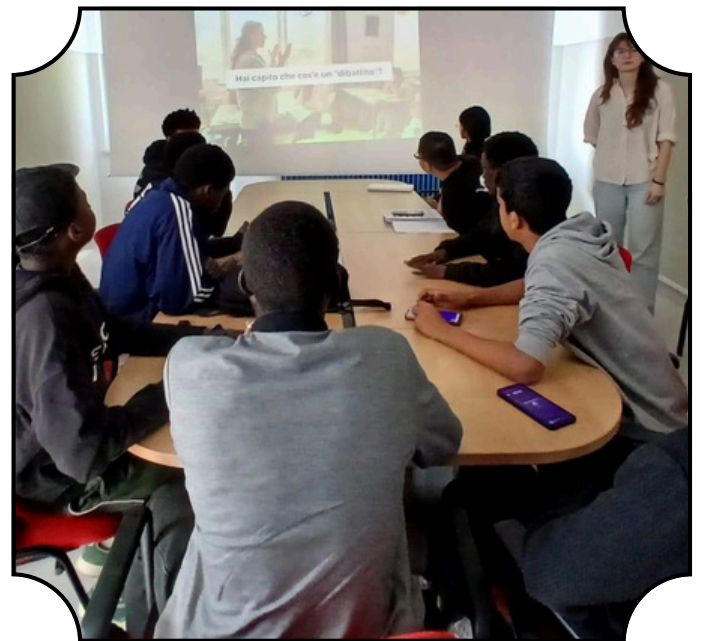
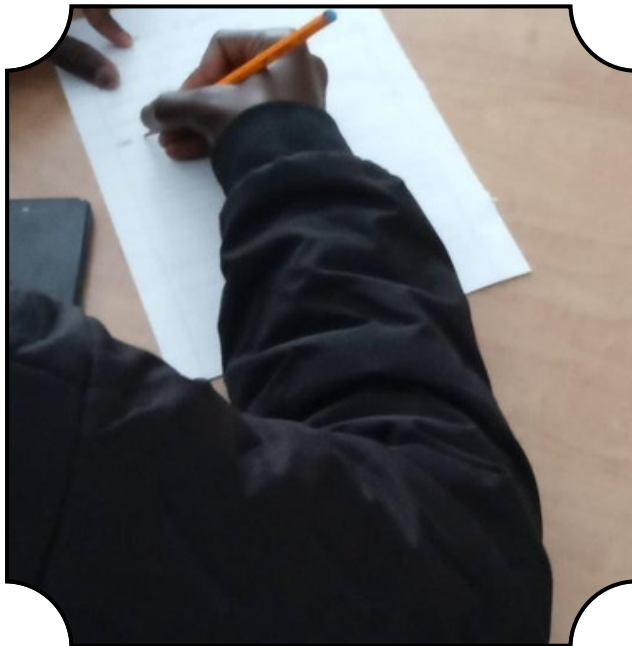

Learning Through Dialogue – Building Safe Spaces for Expression

The debate activities encouraged participants to share opinions, reflect on different perspectives, and work together in a positive group setting. Rather than focusing only on formal speaking skills, the workshops aimed to provide young people with tools for participation, critical thinking, and self-expression in everyday life.
